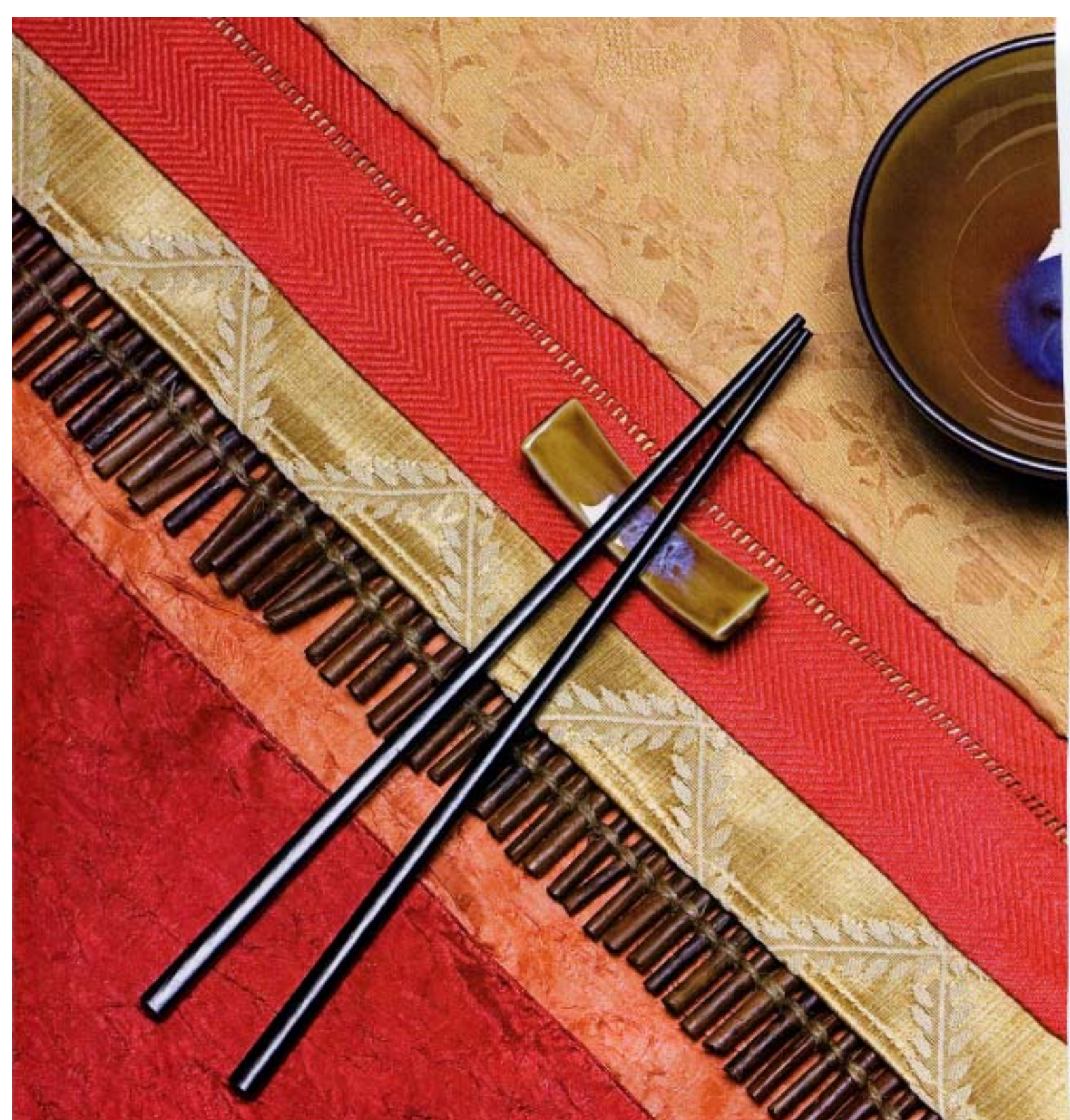


## Plump 'em Up
